A dynamic group of volunteers bring supported recreational programming to adolescents with autism in a safe and calm environment. WAAA is partnering with **We Rock The Spectrum**, a gym for all kids, who is also committed to providing a safe, nurturing, and fun environment to foster learning, exploration and safe sensory experiences. Behavioral health staff will oversee trained volunteers - who are closely monitored and supported. **Gift of Time** staff and mentors provide a crucial sense of normalcy to the children through shared joy and respect.

Pre-registration and admission is required prior to attendance. Once your registration is received and accepted, you will be contacted to schedule a meet and greet, at our Redmond office. Please note – we do need to get to know your child's unique likes, dislikes, challenges, and strengths so we can identify the right volunteer mentor for your child, and be prepared to create a positive experience for all.
